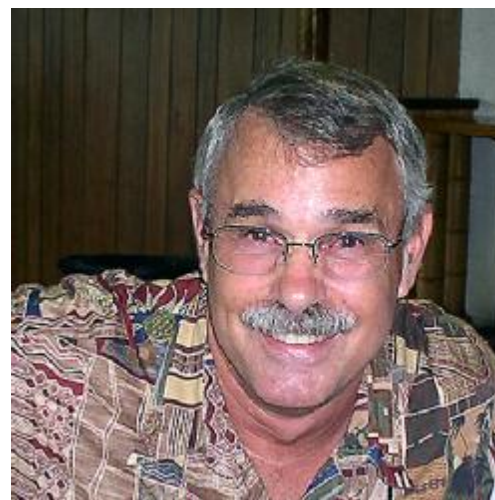

WEINBERG FOUNDATION
